**PROVINCIAL MASONIC BLOOD DONOR WEEK - Results**

The Provincial Masonic Blood Donor Week (PMBDW) was held during the period of February 18<sup>th</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup>, 2013. The donor numbers have been provided by Charlene Goodwin, Regional Partnership Specialist of Canadian Blood Services. The Regional Chairmen were given information in November of last year to be passed on the DDGM's and District Blood Donor Chairmen under their direction.

The results are as follows. As you can see, the total donations and number of donors reinstated in 2012 have almost tripled the numbers recorded in 2010. I would strongly recommend this Grand Lodge Initiative continues during the appropriate week in 2014.

- 150 donations compared to 119 in 2011 and 62 in 2010
- 4 new donors compared to 12 in 2011 and 5 in 2010
- 65 reinstated donors compared to 57 in 2011 and 24 in 2010

Charlene and I have reviewed the results and we feel that three achievements were reached which reflects the continued commitment of both organizations working together.

- The PMBDW was deliberately targeted for a CBS impact week. Impact Days (Monday, February 18 and Tuesday, February 19) were the result from clinic closures on the Boxing Day and Christmas Day Stats (December 26, 27). As clinics are scheduled on a 54 day basis, the clinics on February 18 and 19 would normally experience lighter than normal bookings. The week generated 150 donations for a traditionally slow week.
- The week achieved 69 new and/or reinstated donors which positions them all to donate multiple times before the end of 2013 which will add to the overall Masonic Partners for Life achievements.
- Masons continue to contribute countless volunteer hours at clinics.
